6. The full text of these resolutions is set out in the notice of the Annual General Meeting contained in the circular issued by the Company dated 17 April 2018 which is sent to the shareholders of the Company together with this form of proxy.

Where there are joint holders of any ordinary share(s), any one of such joint holder may vote, either in person or by proxy, in respect of such ordinary share(s) as if he were solely entitled thereto, but if more than one of such joint holders is present at any meeting the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, shall be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holders, and for this purpose seniority shall be determined by the order in which the names stand in the register of members in respect of the joint holding.

To be valid, this form of proxy, together with the power of attorney or other authority, if any, under which it is signed or a certified copy of such power or authority, must be deposited at the Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at Shops 1712-1716, 17th Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong or the principal place of business of the Company in Hong Kong at Units 4607-8, 46th Floor, COSCO Tower, No. 183 Queen's Road Central, Hong Kong, not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the Meeting or adjourned meeting. Completion and return of the form of proxy will not preclude members from attending and voting in person at the Meeting.
9. Any alteration made to this form of proxy must be initialled by the person who signs it.

- (iv) You have the right to request access to and/or correction of your Personal Data in accordance with the provisions of the PDPO.
